1. Hope in the time of trouble

- a) What event occurs just before the glorious return of Jesus? Daniel 12:1-2, Revelation 22:11-12
- b) How can we prepare for this time of trouble right before the glorious return of Jesus? 1 John 3:1-3, John 10:27-29, etc.
- c) What promises of Scripture assure us of God's sustaining presence through even the most intense time of trouble? Psalm 50:15, 27:5, 91:1-11, etc.

2. Hope in the glorious return of Jesus

- a) What promise did Jesus give to His disciples, and to us? John 14:1-3
- b) How did the apostle Paul express his hope in the glorious return of Jesus to Titus? Titus 2:11-14
- c) Compare hope versus hopelessness in the following verses? Isaiah 25:8-9, Revelation 6:14-17
- d) What wonderful events will occur when Jesus returns in glory? 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17, 1 Corinthians 15:51-53
- e) What song will the redeemed sing after the glorious return of Jesus? Revelation 15:2-4
- f) What are your thoughts about singing that song of Moses and the Lamb?

3. The 1000 years on earth and in heaven

- a) Revelation 20:1-3 Where is Satan bound for 1000 years after the glorious return of Jesus? (See Genesis 1:2a) What about the fallen angels who joined Satan in his rebellion against God?
- b) How do the prophets describe the earth during this time of desolation? Jeremiah 4:23-26, 25:33, Isaiah 24:1,3,5
- c) What will the redeemed be doing during this 1000-year period after the glorious return of Jesus? Revelation 20:4,6
- d) If every case has already been settled, what is the value of this time reviewing the judgments of God?
- e) What happens at the conclusion of the 1000 years? Revelation 20:7-9
- f) Why are the wicked raised to life again if they have already been condemned? 2 Corinthians 5:10. Romans 14:10-11, Revelation 20:11-15

4. Eternal life or eternal death

- a) What glorious future awaits the redeemed? John 3:16, 14:23, Revelation 21:1-4, 22:1-5
- b) What dismal future awaits those who have persisted in rebellion? Revelation 20:9, Malachi 4:1-3, Psalm 37:20
- c) How is the unfailing love of God for everyone revealed at the conclusion of the great controversy?
