

1. The Good Shepherd

- a) Psalm 23 (See also Psalm 28:9, 78:52-53, 79:13, 80:1, 100:3)
- b) Where do you see this imagery of the LORD as the Good Shepherd fulfilled in the life of Jesus? John 10:1-6, 7-18, 27-28
- c) Jesus calls His disciples sheep and lambs (Matthew 10:16, Luke 10:3). What reasons do we have to be thankful for our Good Shepherd today?

2. The Suffering Messiah

- a) Psalm 22:1, 14-18, 19-21 Where do you see the details of this psalm fulfilled in the life of Jesus?
- b) Psalm 118:22-23 (quoted by Jesus in all 3 synoptic Gospels: Matthew 21:42, Mark 12:10, Luke 20:17). See also Acts 4:8-12.
- c) Reflect on the inspired testimony of the apostle Peter recorded in 1 Peter 2:21-25. How do you respond to such an amazing revelation of the immeasurable, unending love of God?

3. The Eternal King

- a) Psalm 2:1-12
- b) Psalm 145:1-13

- c) Why did the people quote Psalm 118:26 during the Triumphal Entry of Jesus into Jerusalem?
- d) What vision given to King Nebuchadnezzar and interpreted by the prophet Daniel confirmed the eternal kingdom that God will establish? Daniel 2:31-35,44
- e) What request did a dying thief make to Jesus after trusting in Him as Savior and Lord? Luke 23:39-42
- f) What are your thoughts about not only living eternally with Jesus but also reigning with Him? Revelation 20:6, 3:21

4. The Eternal Priest after the Order of Melchizedek

- a) Psalm 110:4 Who was Melchizedek?
- b) Genesis 14:18-20 – both King of Salem and Priest of the Most High God.
- c) According to the author of the Book of Hebrews, what makes Jesus, our Great High Priest, superior to any other earthly priest? Hebrews 6:19-20, 7:1-3, 20-28
- d) How should we respond, knowing that Jesus is our Great High Priest, now and forever? Hebrews 4:14-16
